

RAS Sports Teams Player Priority Policy

Rationale

- 1. Raglan Area School recognises that we are the largest organisation in the community for youth and understand the importance of delivering a Co-Curricula Sporting Programme.
- 2. It is the responsibility of our school to provide sporting opportunities for our students first and foremost.
- 3. The following guidelines may apply when selecting sporting teams to represent Raglan Area School.

Guidelines

- 1. All Raglan Area School students will have the opportunity to register to play for RAS Sports teams and activities
- 2. Students outside of Raglan Area School will have the opportunity to express an interest to play for RAS Sports Teams that are entered in competitions that allow players outside of the stated school to play
- 3. Raglan Area School will endeavour to place all RAS students into a team for the sport they have registered to play.
- 4. Once all RAS students are placed into teams, if there is still space, places may be offered to students from outside of Raglan Area School who have indicated they would like to play.
- 5. Once team lists are confirmed, they will be submitted via the sports coordinator into the relevant competition if dispensations are required, the sports coordinator will complete these applications
- 6. Confirmed team lists will then be shared with students, whanau and the community.
